

Invitation

The Thirteenth Annual Scientific Meeting of the Institute of Cardiovascular Science and Medicine will be held on 12 December 2009 in Hong Kong. The theme of this year's meeting is: "Co-morbidity hypertension/diabetes: which one do we treat?". It is established that hypertension and diabetes frequently co-exist, a combination which results in an increased risk for cardiovascular disease. Despite advances in cardiovascular therapy, a large proportion of diabetic patients continue to have uncontrolled hyperglycemia, hypertension, and dyslipidemia. In addition, certain medical interventions with established efficacy in the general population do not appear to be equally useful in diabetic patients. Therefore, more stringent goals of therapy should be set for diabetic patients, although achieving these goals will be a challenging task. Through this meeting, we hope to encourage collaboration between basic and clinical researchers, and to stimulate novel concepts and ideas for the understanding and treatment of cardiovascular events in patients with both diabetes and hypertension.




